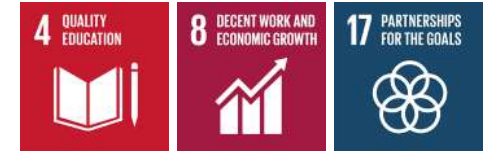
To Enhance Partnership and Excellence GU Signs MoU with SSTLI

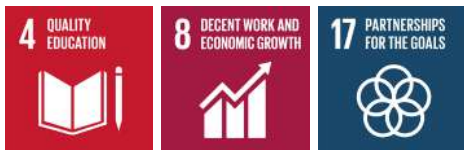

This initiative reflects Gulf University's commitment to fostering creativity and developing students' artistic skills in a supportive and engaging learning environment.



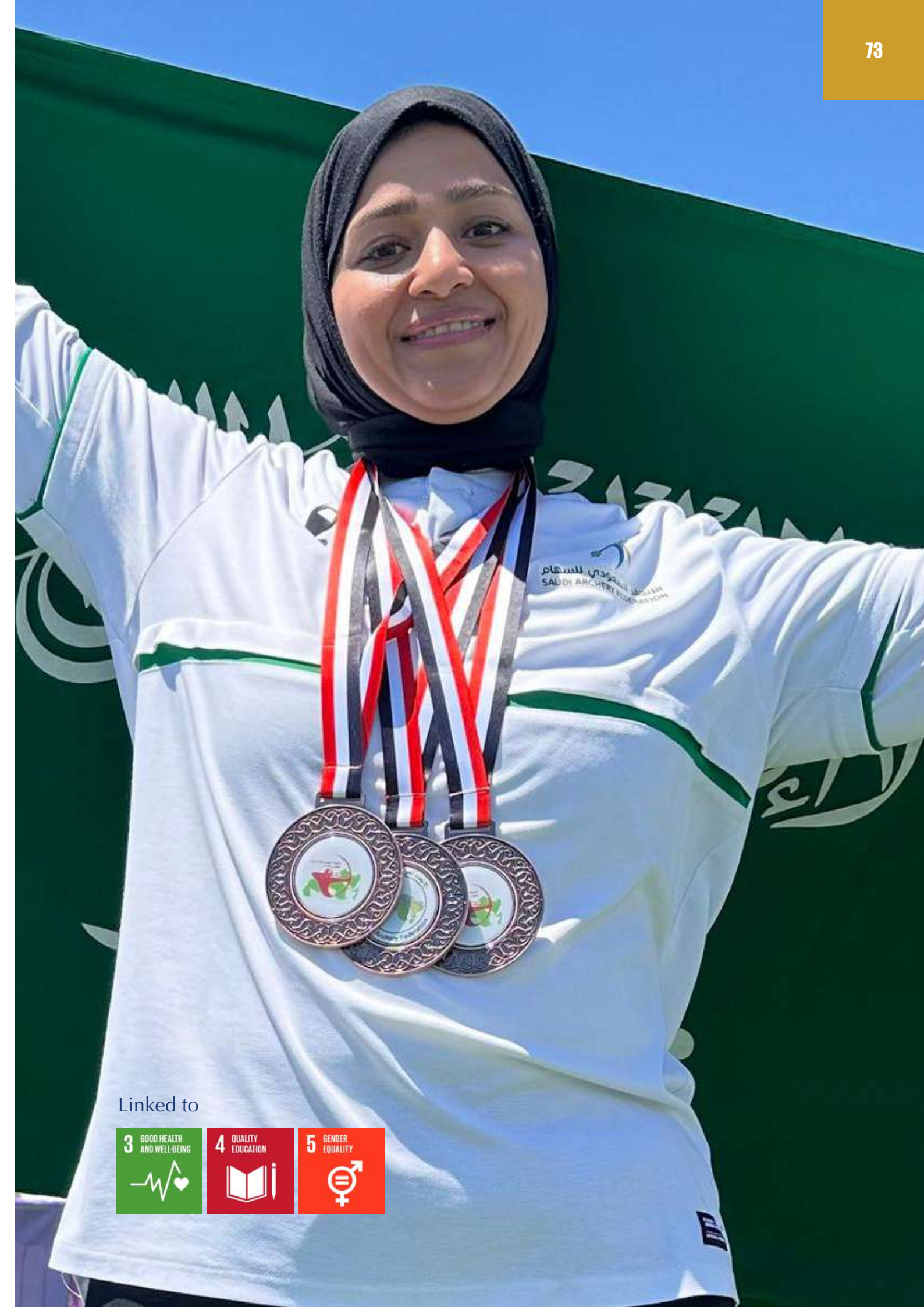
Master's Students Shine with 3 Bronze Medals at Arab Archery Championship
